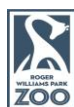

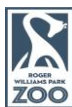

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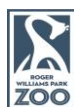
2. Then, think about what it might be like to live in the rainforest and some of the adaptations that the animals in the videos have to help them meet their needs and survive in the rainforest.

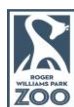
