Animal Care Internship Position Description

POSITION TITLE: Animal Care Internship
CLASSIFICATION: Intern (unpaid)
DEPARTMENT: Animal Care
REPORTS TO: Animal Care Manager/Zoo Keepers/Manager of Volunteer Resources

Summary of Responsibilities:

Interns participating in the Animal Care Internship are responsible for working directly with the Roger Williams Park Zoo animal care staff while rotating through each animal area. This internship is designed to educate people interested in careers with animals and in the field of conservation. This is a volunteer position. It is unpaid and there is no housing provided.

Essential Position Functions:

1. Assist in the cleaning and maintenance of the animal holding areas, exhibits, pools and ponds, exhibit buildings, and zoo grounds associated with exhibits, including roads and paths within the perimeter fence of the animal areas. Service may also be required on exhibits and animals outside of zoo grounds (temporary exhibits, Hasbro Children's Hospital, etc.).
2. Assist in the preparation of animal diets.
3. Assist in the watering and feeding of the animals.
4. Assist in providing enrichment for the animals.
5. Conduct visual and, when appropriate, physical inspections of animals and exhibits.
6. Assist animal care staff in their daily routines.
7. When appropriate, be responsive to visitor inquiries.

Qualifications:

1. Must be at least 18 years old and have completed high school. Age verification may be required.
2. Candidates should have completed at least two years of an undergraduate or graduate program related to wildlife management, conservation biology or a related science degree.
3. Applicants that have volunteer or paid experience with in zoological, veterinary, environmental or wildlife rehab facility are preferred.
4. Must have a recent negative TB test (applicant is responsible for any cost associated with the test).
5. Ability to pass a background check upon selection as an intern.
6. Ability to commit to 34 hours per week: Tuesday-Friday, 8am-4:30pm.
7. Arrive on time and stay for the entire shift.
8. Ability to commit to 11 weeks as an intern (specific dates TBD):
 - Fall: early September-late November
 - Spring: early February-late April
 - Summer: early June-late August
9. Attend an initial orientation prior to start of internship (specific dates TBD).
10. Ability to work independently.
11. Ability to follow all instructions, verbal and written.
12. Ability to walk on uneven surfaces, including stairs.
13. Ability to conduct visual inspections of animals and exhibit areas.
14. Ability to work outside, in all weather.
15. Effectively support the mission and priorities of Roger Williams Park Zoo.
16. Adhere to all policies described in the Roger Williams Park Zoo's Volunteer Handbook.
17. Must be flexible, positive, enthusiastic, approachable, and willing to learn.

Benefits:

1. Free admission to Roger Williams Park Zoo for yourself for duration of the internship.
2. Practical, hands-on experience working with captive wildlife.
3. Good resume builder with potential opportunities for professional development and workshops.
4. Opportunity to earn credit for college (dependent on college requirements).
