POSTION TITLE: American Burying Beetle Volunteer- Conservation Program
CLASSIFICATION: Volunteer
DEPARTMENT: Conservation

Summary of Responsibilities:

American burying beetle volunteers will work under the direct supervision of the Roger Williams Park Zoo Director of Conservation Programs. This is a unique opportunity to participate directly in an endangered species recovery program. Volunteers will assist the Director of Conservation Programs with the American burying beetle captive breeding population.

Essential Position Functions:

- Assist in the cleaning and maintenance of the American burying beetle colony.
- As directed, set up and maintenance of breeding pairs of American burying beetles.
- Assist with maintenance of feeder insect colonies.
- Conduct visual and, when directed, physical inspections of the American burying beetle colony and active reproductive pairs.
- Assist conservation staff with record keeping.
- Assist conservation staff in conducting and analyzing research.
- Assist conservation staff with sample and data collection.

Qualifications:

- 18 years or older and completion of minimum one year of college-level biological science coursework.
- Minimum time commitment of 40 hours per year to the program.
- Ability to work independently.
- Ability to follow all instructions, verbal and written.
- Adhere to ethical and confidentiality codes.
- Ability to lift a minimum of 50 pounds.
- Ability to conduct visual inspections of animals and facilities.
- Ability to pass a criminal background check upon selection.
- Ability to make a weekly time commitment for a minimum of 6 consecutive months.
- Effectively support the mission and priorities of Roger Williams Park Zoo.
- Adhere to all policies described in the Roger Williams Park Zoo's Volunteer Handbook.
