Summary of Responsibilities:

Horticulture Volunteers are primarily responsible for helping maintain and grow the beautiful gardens and grounds of the Roger Williams Park Zoo and Carousel Village. Volunteers will help directly with the Horticulture Department to plant, water, rake, and prune all while learning about diverse plant species and the practices of landscaping.

Essential Position Functions:

1. Help plant seedlings and mature plants in pots, greenhouse, and on zoo grounds
2. Aid in the maintenance of zoo gardens through weeding, watering, and deadheading plants
3. Assist Horticulture staff with special projects
4. Help with the general landscaping of the zoo grounds
5. Aid in trimming and gathering plants used in the diets of zoo animals

Qualifications:

1. Must have an interest in gardening and horticulture.
2. Previous experience gardening (personal gardening and plant care or professional) preferred.
3. Must be at least 18 years old. Age verification may be required.
4. Ability to pass a background check upon selection as a Horticulture Volunteer.
5. Actively participate in a three hour training/orientation hosted by Roger Williams Park Zoo.
6. Arrive on time and stay for the entire shift (unless you have supervisory approval to the contrary).
7. Ability to be outside, in all weather and extreme temperatures (greenhouse conditions).
8. Ability to lift up to 25 pounds.
9. Effectively support the mission and priorities of Roger Williams Park Zoo.
10. Adhere to all policies described in the Roger Williams Park Zoo's Volunteer Handbook.
11. Must be flexible and willing to learn.
12. Experience with Tropical Plants highly desired- however not required.
